Narrative:

July has been a busy month for the helicopter in response to human-elephant conflict. I camped out with the rangers in Isokon in the Transmara for several nights to be able to respond to the HEC in the area effectively. Large herds were coming up into the farms from the Mara Conservancy as night fell. The rangers would then listen for shouts of distress from the farmers and rush to the different farms during the night. The farmers and the rangers coordinated efforts to push out the elephants. We used the helicopter to move the elephants farther away from the escarpment; pushing them deep into the Mara Conservancy. This meant that they would only be able to get to the top of the escarpment by 3am or not at all. Being based at the camp saved significant ferry time back and forth to the MEP HQ.

We are -34,170USD in arrears on the helicopter account.
