TANAPA rangers in the Serengeti

Narrative:

This month Kenya Wildlife Service completed a 500-hour maintance service of the helicopter. The slight dents in the blades from touching tree leaves were measured and passed inspection, which comes as a relief as a new pair of blades and spindle costs \$52,000.

Unfortunately in June no new donations were received toward flying time for the helicopter. This is something we will need to focus on as we are currently operating in the red for helicopter usage.

Conflict in the Serengeti continues and the TANAPA warden requested that we return a herd of elephants from farms back to the park.

The area continues to dry up and as a result elephant herds seem to be amalgamating into super herds or clans. During the operation on the 15th of June we counted a clan of over 100 individuals in the Mosiro area, which is a daunting thought for a farmer in this area.
