

## Helicopter Report May 2017

## Narrative:

We have received \$20,000 from Erica Hoyng and John Dillow toward MEP helicopter flying hours. This will cover approximately two months of flying. Additional funding is needed to keep flying at our current rate. We estimate that at the end off May we will have flown 500 hours, which means that a major service will be conducted in June by the KWS Airwing in Nairobi.

In response to continued insecurity in the Mau Forest we did two reconnaissance missions with KWS and Mike Prettejohn.

HEC has increased this month and the helicopter has been vital in moving elephants into safe areas from farms.

We reacted to an injured baby elephant on the 20<sup>th</sup> of May and successfully separated him from his mother so he could be treated.

On the 25<sup>th</sup> of May we were able to find and re-collar elephant Mytene in the Serengeti National Park with TANAPA.
